






A programmer is someone who writes/creates computer software or applications generally by providing instructions (commonly through the use of a specific programming language) to the computer.






REQUIREMENTS FOR PROGRAMMERS



- upper-intermediate knowledge of English;
- skill to work in team;
- ability to think abstractly;
- knowledge of mathematics;
- responsibility, ability to determine and meet deadlines;
- readiness for constant self-learning.



WHO CAN BECOME A PROGRAMMER?

You can become a programmer at any age. The profession is suitable for men and women with good analytical skills, logic, knowledge of mathematics and, of course, English. In programming, not only practical skills are important, but also ideas.



PROGRAMMER SPECIALIZATIONS



Developers can be divided into two categories depending on their specialization.



Application programmers

They develop application software - games, accounting programs, editors, instant messengers, etc. They also adapt existing programs to the needs of a specific organization or user.



System programmers

They develop operating systems, robots, work with networks, write interfaces to various distributed databases. They write code for hardware. Systems programmers are among the rarest and highest paid.



- research centers, universities








PROGRAMMING CAREER: JUNIOR, MIDDLE, SENIOR

Junior is not a zero level programmer, but a beginner programmer level after training and some practice. At work, juniors carry out assigned small parts of the project, and not the entire project.







PROGRAMMING CAREER: JUNIOR, MIDDLE, SENIOR

A middle is a completely independent programmer who can cope with any task. A middle must understand the goals and objectives of the product he is developing, as well as have a good understanding of the subject area in which he works






PROGRAMMING CAREER: JUNIOR, MIDDLE, SENIOR
